

To qualify for the Food Bank – you must reside within the Northampton Area School District and must have a household income that falls below 150% of the Federal Poverty guidelines. Also the following must be provided: **1.** Proof of residency within the Northampton Area School District (lease, mortgage, utility bill) **only if current address is not on picture ID**

2. Photo ID for everyone in the household 18 years or older. **We do not need to see the individuals, just their ID's and copies are acceptable**

3. A birth certificate for any household member 17 years of age or younger (or official proof of the minor's residency in the home).

Please know that if you do not have these items you may not count person(s) in your household size and your income threshold will be lowered to a household size you are able to document.

Commodity Supplemental Food Program

The Commodity Supplemental Food Program was implemented to improve the health of Senior Citizens through better nutrition. Participants must be 60 years of age or older and meet income requirements. Qualified seniors will receive a monthly box of food that contains a variety of basic staples.

To register for CSFP seniors need to show Proof of age, residency and household income.
